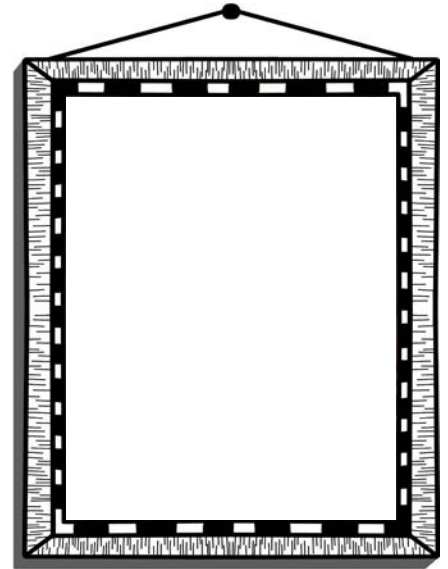

F. Luis Mora was born on July 27, 1874 in Uruguay. His father, Domingo, was a sculptor who taught Luis and his brother, Jo, how to draw.

Luis would grow up to be a famous artist after studying in Boston and New York City. He was also an art teacher! He and his wife, Sonia, eventually moved to Connecticut, where their daughter Rosemary was born.

Luis continued making art his whole life, but even the biggest painting usually started with a small drawing.

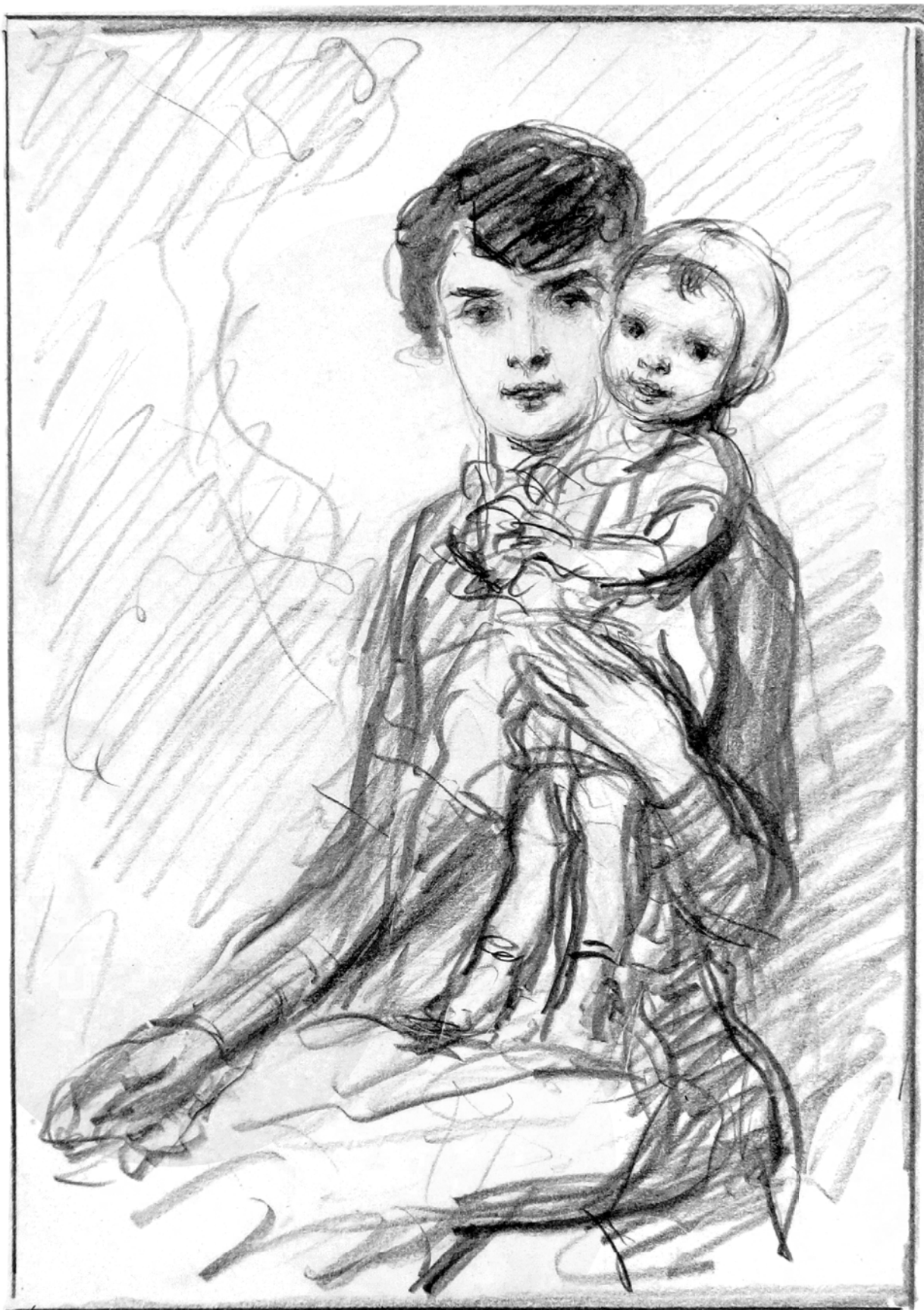
