What is the student art exhibition?

In the Spring semester, the Housatonic Museum of Art (HMA) partners with the CT State Housatonic Visual Arts Department to host an exhibition of student work across all media.

Who is eligible to submit?

CT State Housatonic students who have completed at least 1 course in the CT State Housatonic Visual Arts Department in the Fall 2025 or Spring 2026 semester are eligible to submit **1-3 ready to hang artworks**. Submission does not guarantee display. We encourage artworks completed as part of the course, though it is not a requirement.

How do I submit?

Students can drop off **1-3 ready to hang artworks** in the Burt Chernow Galleries on one of these dates:

- Monday, April 20, 2026 from 9am - 4pm
- Tuesday, April 21, 2026 from 9am - 3pm

“Ready to hang” means that it is framed and has a wire on the back, if applicable.
